



HOLIDAY TAKE-HOME KIT: FRIENDSHIP POSTCARDS

This take-home kit is provided by Calgary Public Library to help you and your family have a fun and engaging time together, both at home and out in the community. It's yours to keep!

MATERIALS INCLUDED

- Blank postcards
- Coloured pencils and pens
- Stickers
- Postage stamp to mail one postcard within Canada

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Use the coloured pencils, pens, and stickers to decorate the front of one of the postcards.
2. On the back of the postcard, write a message to the friend or family member you want to send the postcard to. Write the message in the unlined section on the left side of the postcard only. If you don't know what to write, you can tell them what you enjoy about school, or what your favourite part of the holidays is, or just say "Hello!"
3. Fill in your friend or family member's name and address on the lines on the back of the postcard.
4. Attach the stamp to the back of the postcard in the upper right corner. If you are sending your postcard to someone who lives outside of Canada, or if you are sending more than one postcard, you will need to buy extra postage from the post office.
5. Take your postcard to the post office or drop it into a mailbox to mail it.
6. Recycle or reuse the leftover materials. They are yours to keep!
